2018 North American Junior & Young Rider Championships ("NAJYRC")

Groom (Overview)

The **North American Junior & Young Rider Championships ("NAJYRC")** are held annually in the summer. The NAJYRC is the pinnacle of a young rider's equestrian achievement. Teams from all areas of the U.S. as well as from Canada, Mexico, Bermuda, the Bahamas and the Caribbean are invited to compete in this international championship event. Special invitations have also included countries from South America. The NAJYRC is also recognized as the official Junior Olympics for Equestrian Sport by the United States Olympic Committee. In the Eventing competition, each area will send a team (and select individuals) to represent their area, as designated within the United States Eventing Association. From very early on, many young riders see this as a potential goal for themselves as they progress through the levels of competition.

Area VI Young Riders have done very well in recent years! In 2017, one of our CH-YR** riders placed 4th in a very competitive field of eighteen starters and our CH-J* team brought home the **Team Gold Medal** while one team member earned an additional individual **Bronze Medal**. In 2013 and 2015 Area VI had riders finish in the top 10. In 2012, our CH-YR** team brought home **Team Gold**. In 2011, our CH-J* team brought home the **Team Silver Medal** – with two of our riders finishing in the Top 10. In 2010, our CH-J* team brought home the **Team Gold Medal**, while our CH-YR** team earned the **Team Silver Medal**. Also in 2010, Area VI won BOTH the CH-YR** and CH-J* **Individual Gold**. NAJYRC 2009 saw another CH-YR** **Individual Gold** for Area VI, a CH-YR** **Team Gold** and a CH-J* **Bronze**. NAJYRC 2008 saw Area VI achieve double **Gold** at the CH-YR** level.

In 2018, the NAJYRC will be held at Rebecca Farm, Kalispell, MT, July 20-22, 2018. Area VI expects to send two full teams (CH-J* and CICOY**). We also hope to send up to two additional individuals at each level.

Current Area VI Young Riders who are interested in grooming at NAJYRC are encouraged to let us know. The number of grooms that will attend NAJYRC depends on the number of riders going.. Age, experience, work ethic and sportsmanship are all criteria for being chosen to be a groom at NAJYRC. As with all Area VI rider candidates, if all factors are equal between two groom candidates, the participation of each in other Area VI Young Rider programs or activities (i.e. fundraising, securing of team sponsorship, etc.) may be considered.

IMPORTANT NOTE TO RIDER CANDIDATES: Any rider candidate wishing to be considered for a groom position (if not selected to ride) is required to send in (via email) an Area VI 2018 NAJYRC Groom Application to Area VI Young Rider Coordinator, Kristin Hogan (khogan@sonic.net) no later than January 31, 2018. A rider candidate's individual fundraising commitment of \$500 by June 15, 2018 supersedes any further fundraising requirement as outlined in the Groom Application.

Groom Qualifications:

- Current member of Area VI Young Rider program;
- MUST have eventing experience...preferably at the Preliminary level or above;
- Preference given for individuals who have groomed/competed at FEI or 3-Day events;
- Must attend Area VI Spring Camp (March 10-11, 2018) and Summer Camp (June 21-24, 2018) both @ Twin Rivers Ranch, Paso Robles, CA;
- Be able to travel to NAJYRC for a week in July 2018 (dates TBD)...All grooms' transportation & accommodation expenses are covered by Area VI Young Rider program and meals throughout the event are provided by Area VI team families and the event organizer. Grooms are encouraged to bring pocket money for snacking and small item purchases at event;
- Grooms are supplied with team apparel (polo shirts, XC shirts, jackets, etc.) at no charge;
- MUST participate fully in all YR fundraisers and agree to personally raise \$250.00 by June 15, 2018 which monies will be put directly towards the Area VI teams and NAJYRC;
- MUST be a hard worker, team player and have a good sense of humor;
- Provide a trainer, Pony Club or barn owner reference with Application;
- In order to drive one of the team golf carts used at NAJYRC you MUST have a current & valid drivers' license.

Individuals interested in becoming an Area VI NAJYRC Groom should complete the attached Groom Application and submit prior to deadline on January 31, 2018. NAJYRC grooms will be announced on June 5, 2018.
